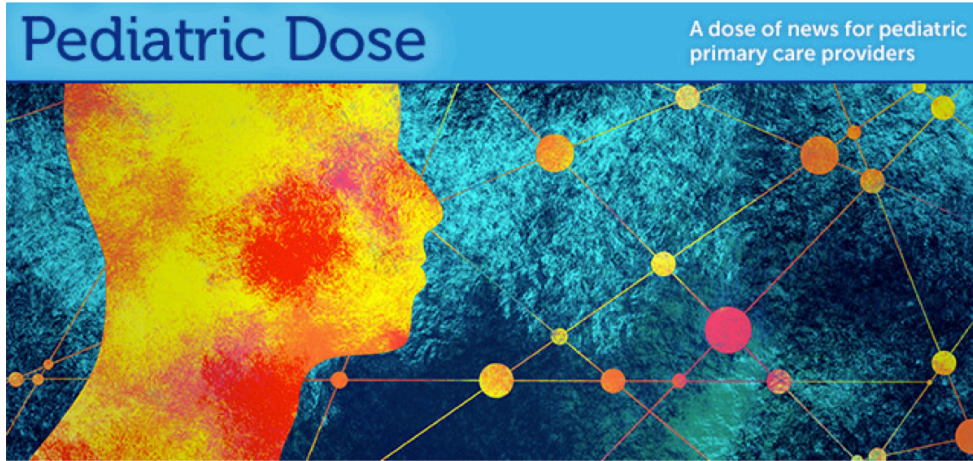


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10 things every pediatrician should know about eating disorders

Too often, all eating disorders are lumped together with one simple solution: eat more. But it's far more complicated than that.

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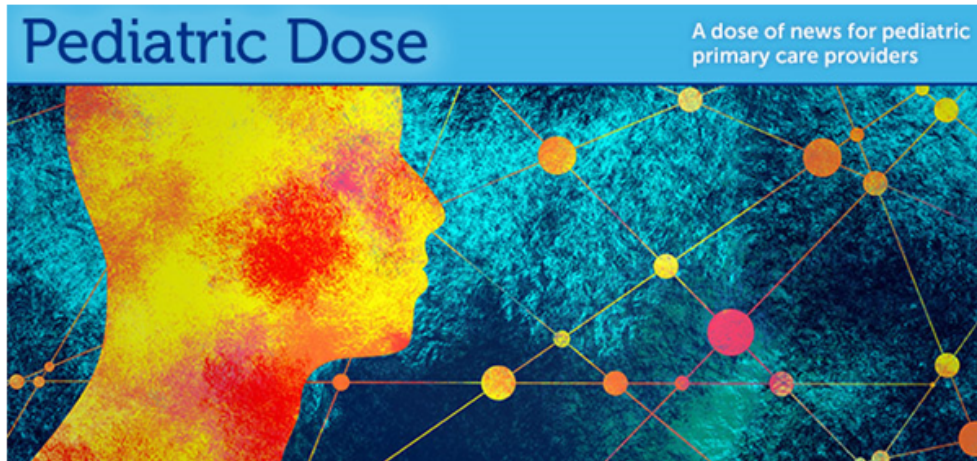


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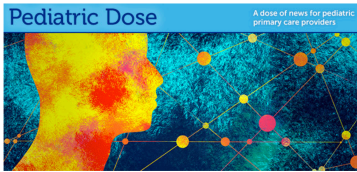


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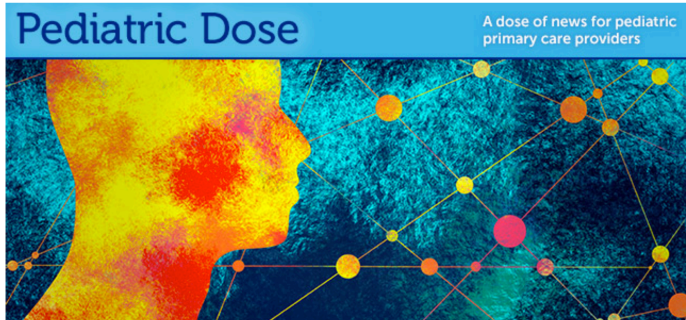
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
